## A RESOLUTION

Offered by MR. BARTON Deal

*Be it resolved by the Committee on Energy and Commerce,* that upon the adoption of this Resolution, the Chairman of the Committee on Energy and Commerce, with the concurrence of the Ranking Minority Member, may authorize and issue subpoenas to testify and subpoenas *duces tecum* to any person or entity in respect of matters involved in, relating to, or arising from the Committee's investigation of data brokers and "pretexting," and its investigation of the Hewlett-Packard Company's efforts to obtain access to confidential personal records of the Company's Board of Directors and others.

This Resolution is adopted pursuant to Rule XI, clause 2(m)(1) and (3) of the Rules of the U.S. House of Representatives.

The powers set forth by this resolution will expire upon the dissolution of the 109<sup>th</sup> Congress, *sine die*.
