**AMENDMENT**

**OFFERED BY MR. PITTS OF PENNSYLVANIA**  
*and T. Murphy*

In section 610(a)(110 of the Public Utility Regu-  
latory Policies Act of 1978, as added by section 101 of  
<sup>HR 2454</sup>  
the ~~(discussion draft)~~, insert “(A)” after the heading, re-  
designate subparagraphs (A) through <sup>(H)</sup>~~(F)~~ as clauses (i)  
through (vii), and add the following at the end thereof:

1           (B) In the case of a retail electric supplier  
2           in a State which has enacted a State require-  
3           ment that a minimum quantity of electric en-  
4           ergy sold to consumers in the State by that  
5           supplier be derived from a particular form of  
6           energy (whether described as “renewable en-  
7           ergy” or “alternative energy” or otherwise), in  
8           applying this section, the term “renewable en-  
9           ergy” shall mean the form of energy covered by  
10          such State law in lieu of the meaning provided  
11          by subparagraph (A).
