AINS-EC

Add at the end of subtitle C of title I of division B
the following:

1 SEC. 1159. PROTECTION FOR PHYSICIAN SERVICES IN
2 EMERGENCY DEPARTMENTS.

3 Section 1867 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
4 1395) is amended by adding at the end the following new
5 subsection:

6 “(j) PROTECTION FOR PHYSICIANS’ SERVICES IN
7 CONNECTION WITH EMERGENCY SERVICES.—In the case
8 of a physician who—

9 “(1) provided an appropriate medical screening
10 examination under subsection (a);

11 “(2) determined, through such screening, that
12 the individual being screened does not have an emer-
13 gency medical condition, as defined under subsection
14 (e)(1); and

15 “(3) based on such determination, transferred
16 such individual to another facility that provides med-
17 ical services,

1 the provisions of section 224(g) of the Public Health Serv-
2 ice Act shall apply to the physician with respect to such
3 actions in the same manner as an employee of an entity
4 described in paragraph (4) of such section.”.
